These works to the trees are to be carried out to ensure we do not damage tree 1 as per our sketch plan as we carry out our works at the property to the rear of 26 New End Square NW3 1JA.

We seek permission to carry out the works consisting of a - 2 meters crown reduce overall and a 5.2 meters crown lift, so that the skip lorries can reverse into site without damaging the tree.

All works to the trees will be carried out as per our Tree Protection and Construction Method Statement which is attached with this application.

As we progress with works on site, we will strictly adhere to the Tree Protection and Construction Method Statement attached which was produced by Aboricultural Solutions LLP and executed by a properly qualified and experienced tree contracting company - in this case Gristwood and Toms who have been established for 40+ Years and one of the UK's largest tree contractors.
