REAR GARDEN Routine management to trees BS 3998 2010

T5 Magnolia Grandiflora x 1 Reduce height by up to 1 meters and prune overlong branches to contain crown and root-spread remove dead/dying/crossing branches

T7 Ash (fraxinus) Previously snapped out main stem leaving the tree one sided with signs of a weeping union. Reduce remainder of the crown by up to 3 meters to lesson any future risk of overlong limbs failing, clean out crown and remove any major dead-wood, prune to suitable growth points with furnishing growth for crown continuity.

T8 Beech (fagus sylvatica) reduce height but up to 2 meters, prune to crown-line any overlong branches, remove dead/dying/dangerous branches, prune to suitable growth points to shape. tree situated in rear corner close to 2 solid walls. Works in-line with routine tree management and to contain crown and root-spread

T9 Yew (taxus) Crown reduce and shape by up to 2 meters in height and to round off the tree to shape. To contain crown and root-spread T11 Pear fell to ground level (permission previously granted)

T12 Silver Birch (betula pendula) Bad historic pruning works. Reduce overlong branches to form a natural looking crown-line (best practice)
