1 Reasons for approving details:

The submitted details for conditions 3(c) and 3(d) have been reviewed by the Council's Conservation Officer who has confirmed that the proposed use of London Stock Brick as the facing material and a combination of Westmorland Slate, Rolled Lead Roofing, Terracotta Angle Ridge Tiles and Lead Ridges for the roof, are considered sufficient to demonstrate that the special architectural and historic interest of the building would be safeguarded.

No objections were received prior to making this decision. The full impact of the

proposed development has already been assessed.

As such, the submitted details are in general accordance with policy D2 of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017, and are sufficient to discharge conditions 3(c) and 3(d).
