1 Reasons for approving details:

The submitted details for condition 3(a) have been reviewed by the Council's Conservation Officer who has confirmed that the proposed joinery details for the new window casements, doors, staircase, banisters, and skirting are considered sufficient to demonstrate that the appearance of the premises and the character of the immediate area would be safeguarded.
