The details contained within the Arboricultural Method Statement (AMS) are considered sufficient to demonstrate that the tree to be retained on the



neighbouring site will be adequately protected during construction works. The report has been revised to now show specific details of how the tree in the garden of the adjacent property of 83 Fitzjohn's Avenue will be retained during the construction works, in order to address concerns by the Council's tree officer.
