Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The proposed mansard roof extension, by reason of its location, height, bulk and design, would result in an incongruous addition that would harm the largely unimpaired roof line of this terrace of buildings, resulting in significant harm to the non-designated heritage asset and so would be detrimental to the character and appearance of the host building, the terrace and the streetscene, contrary to policy D1 (Design) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.
