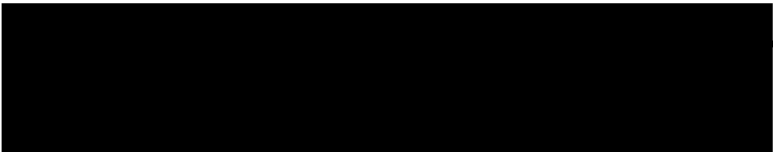
Hello,

It's so important to support independent businesses when more and more chains are coming to the area.

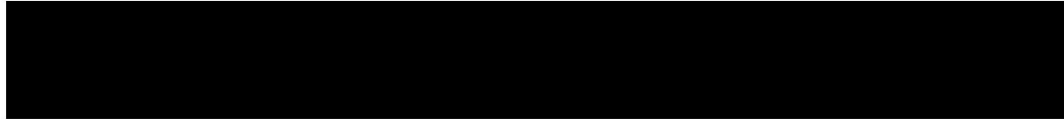
I support his application for permission for a storage unit on the retail forecourt to support his business. I urge the council to approve planning permission.
