Proposal: Hard and soft landscaping works including boundary treatment, furniture, planting, associated works, a dedicated secure entrance for the boaters from Granary Street and facilities such as washing machines, storage and WCs within timber-clad boater's sheds. Works in connection with redevelopment of the site under 2016/6311/P dated 14/07/2017 (variation of 2014/4385/P dated 18/03/2015) for new 6-13 storey buildings with employment space, residential units and associated works

Location: Land adjacent to 101 Camley Street, Granary Street and Regent's Canal, London

Waterway: Regent's Canal
