**Subject: DROP-IN SESSION** 

I attended the Drop-In session yesterday evening, arranged by the GOSH CCC Project Team.

It was very disappointing that no-one was there from SISK to answer questions about the revised Demolition and Construction Management Plan.

Nor was the person deputed to answer questions about traffic and highways well informed or fully briefed, unaware for example that the eastern arm of Great Ormond Street and Millman Street is proposed to take all north-bound traffic and two-way cycles. He said that the north section of Lamb's Conduit Street might remain two-way, but was unsure.

He also said, I'm sure incorrectly, that the DCMP wasn't part of the application and could be amended as the scheme progressed. That was not very reassuring.

I will, of course, be submitting my comments on the proposed revisions to 2022/2255/P in line with LB Camden's public consultation timetable, but in terms of community engagement by the applicant, yesterday's event was not particularly satisfactory.
