I understand you are the person to contact with regard to the proposed Great Ormond Street re-development.

Unfortunately I was unable to attend the meeting on November 10th at the Paul O'Gorman building but I was passed your email by neighbours so I could express my concern about the proposal.

I have lived in the area for 20 years and feel strongly that the proposed plans will be extremely damaging to the community who live and work there. The disruption to independent local businesses, struggling to get back on their feet post pandemic, as well as the impact on residents like myself in terms of noise and pollution is likely to be extremely high.

Great Ormond Street is of course an amazing hospital and I can see this is a very emotive situation. However, the proposed plans, if I have understood them correctly, seem to entail a huge building that must inevitably affect light for those in Lambs Conduit Street and Great Ormond Street itself, and involve years of building work.

I believe that the hospital has outgrown it's current site and the plans are simply not tenable when the full impact to the community is taken into account.
