Dear Tree team,

2022/4827/T: Tree felling at 22 Lindfield Gardens

Trees, including those in rear gardens, are vital to the special character of the Redington Frogna Conservation Area and to the Redington Frogna Ecological Network.

The Forum therefore requests that, as a general principle, trees are preserved from felling on trivial grounds and that they are allowed to reach full maturity.

Where trees are interfering with garden paving, the Forum requests that the paving is simply removed or resited, in order to preserve the trees. This is in line with Camden Planning Guidance.

It is unclear what could be meant by “overgrown” or “too high” and which trees are proposed for felling. However, unless they are dead or dying, the Forum requests that all trees are preserved, namely T2, T3, T4, T5 and T6.

For T1, which is to be felled because it is dead, the Forum requests one or more native trees to be planted in replacement.
