The proposed telecommunications equipment would protrude aggressively into the skyline and would be visible from locations throughout the Conservation Area and also from Hampstead Heath. It would also loom over and dominate the adjacent St. Mary's Brookfield, which is a Grade II* listed building. There is no possibility of screening, either natural or man-made. Visual clutter, in such an exposed position, would therefore cause serious visual harm not only to the Conservation Area but also to St Mary's. The proposed telecommunications equipment thus would cause substantial harm to the Conservation Area and to the character and setting of St Mary's.</p>
