I wish to register my objection to the above application.

As a resident of the local area who has experienced living with major construction over a long period of time, I know the negative impact this will have on the residents within this area if this build goes ahead. In order to build this new office block, 18 perfectly good homes will be demolished and 18 families will lose their homes. Vulnerable residents will be subjected to years of construction and noise and air pollution. The building in place currently is only 55 years old, not only are there plenty of other uses that building could take up in its current form, tearing it down for a new office block will have a major negative environmental impact for years. And from what I can see this will have absolutely no benefit to the local community as the "affordable" units of which there are only 9, are in no way at all affordable to the vast majority of residents.
