Sedum Roof

Additional Planting Species and Density

The Sedum will be supplied in a density of 85%.

The Sedum blankets contain Sedum Album, Sedum Acre, Sedum Anglicum, Sedum Fosterianum, which are all varieties native to the UK. We will also include Sedum Hispanicum, Sedum Rupestre, and Sedum Sexangulare.

Due to the increased depth of planting to 80mm we will create 3 planting pockets per m2 and add in a mixture of Sempervivums, Cotula hispida, Carex glauca, Carex elata "Aurea", and Origanum vulgare.

Maintenance

We advise that the roof is checked thoroughly in the early spring to monitor performance and carry out any action required to maintain a beautiful, colourful roof year in and year out.

This annual maintenance can be carried out by a contractor, or by the resident.

During each visit slow release plant feed (*Harrowden Sedum Fertiliser is reccomended*) should be scattered which will ensure that these plants are well nourished so that they will be able to withstand summertime droughts and winter frosts.

If there are any sparce patches perhaps due to squirrels or wear and tear these can be planted up with suckers and all the gutters and drainage should also be checked.
