The above application was advertised on the 18th November. We see that it appears to have been granted on the 23rd November and that there are no public documents.

We are very concerned to note that the application is for internally illuminated fascia signage (these are not usually allowed within the Conservation Area, and especially on a non-primary residential frontage such as Mary Terrace.

The Committee wishes to strongly object to the application - obviously we would be able comment in more detail if drawings were available.

Please can you clarify why the application has been granted so quickly and what the basis for the decision-making is?
