As a local resident, I would like to register my objection to the proposed redevelopment of 1 Museum Street on the grounds of its size.

Its proposed height is greatly out of proportion with the surrounding area, and it will be a blight on the historic skyline. It is also likely to block out a considerable amount of natural light to the surrounding buildings such as the LSE High Holborn accommodation and West Central Street (which it would also disrupt severely during the building phase).

It is also difficult to understand the need for such an expansive structure when so many offices and other buildings are vacant in the surrounding areas (Holborn/Kingsway and Bloomsbury). It would not only be an out of place eyesore, it would likely struggle to fill much of the space.
