Dear Patrick Marfleet

My mother and I live at 16c Great Ormond Street and have concerns re: the proposed GOSH development as it stands. We both attended the drop-in session at GOSH a few weeks ago and are deeply worried about the following items:

- 1) 30 ton lorries causing road danger, diesel particulate pollution, dust, disruption and reckless noise and vibration
- 2) Excessive building size and A/C noise
- 3) Failure to consult or engage meaningfully with the local community
- 4) Risk to community children in local hospitals, schools, Coram's Fields from respiratory/other illnesses caused by fumes/waste/emissions
- 5) Current site has outgrown hospital needs and is no longer fit for purpose
- 6) Hundreds of objections unanswered
- 7) Plans do not reflect original proposal
- 8) Devastation of local community - Local businesses and livelihoods will be sincerely impacted. The area will become unrecognisable.

There ought to be a better solution for the building plans to be altered so that it is not such a drastic project, in which the hospital can get what it needs without unnecessary expenditure.
