I refer to this application to facilitate two new temporary vehicular accesses from Granary Street into the St Pancras Hospital site during the construction of the new Oriol hospital during 2023-27. There is no consultation period but I wish to raise an issue.

As far as I can see, no analysis of the impact on the cycle lane on St Pancras Way has been made. The new entrances will presumably result in a lot more motor traffic turning in to Granary Street from St Pancras Way across the cycle lane, increasing the potential for 'left-hook' collisions. Have the developers suggested any mitigating measures, including the possibility of routing traffic via Camley Street rather than via St Pancras Way?
