I am writing to comment on the applicant on the proposal on new Children's Cancer Centre.

I actually got to speak one of the staff who is currently working at the hospital, and they told me that despite the new renovation, the hospital had out grown the space. Some of their staff need to work from home and their offices are not even included in the planning.

They could not see why the trust is pushing this proposal to renovate in the tight premise, instead of seeking some other area which they could build the hospital with better infrastructure in place, such as visitor/staff car park (especially when the number of strikes are happening, and patients and family have to travel in this cold weather), and more office space.

We have heard the views and opinions from the trust, however, we have not heard any views on actual day to day staff and patients who are in the hospital. They seem not to agree or not sure about the proposal.
