Subject: 2022/5344/T objection

CRASH would like to object to the removal of the tree in the front “garden” paved drive at 84 Goldhurst Terrace - 2022/5344/T posted on 7 December.

CRASH notes that the application has been submitted as a “DD 5 Day Notice FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Strawberry tree (T1) - Fell to ground level” with no comment period due to it being an “emergency action” which is acceptable when trees are dead or felt to be dangerous.

However no evidence or reason has been provided with the application to substantiate this being the case. The tree is not dead – but ivy appears to have been allowed to grow into the tree. Whether it is “dangerous” has not been evidenced. Photos from previous years show this to be an attractive tree in the front “garden”.

Trees in front gardens are an important feature of the conservation area and highly visible from the public domain. Retention of trees is in line with Camden’s policies and this application should be refused.
