1 Reason for approval of details:

The application is for the approval of blinds which are to be fitted to the roof lights of the single storey rear extension which was granted planning permission at 62 Falkland Road under planning permission 2021/5802/P on 28/06/2022.

Details of the blinds are required to prevent glare and overlooking from the proposed extension to the detriment of the amenity of occupiers of the upper

floor rooms at the adjoining properties.

The VELUX black-out and anti-heat blinds which have been submitted would mitigate against glare from the extension and they would prevent upward looking from the extension to windows above in adjoining properties.

The condition states that the blinds must be closed when the lights are on.

As such the submitted details comply with the requirements of the condition and the details can therefore be approved.

The full impact of the proposed development has already been assessed.

As such, the proposed development is in general accordance with policy A1 of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.
