1 Reasons for approval-

The submitted plan shows that a covered cycle shelter will be provided on the rear first floor flat roof of 112-114 Kilburn High Road. The cycle shelter would contain 5 Sheffield stands (10 spaces) which meets not only the requirements of Condition 4 but also the requirements for the other flats permitted under planning permissions 2021/0610/P and 2021/0492/P.

The full impact of the proposed development has already been assessed. The
