The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The replacement shopfront, by reason of its layout, proportions, detailed design and materials, disrupts the historical elevational composition of a building which contributes positively to the Hampstead Conservation Area, causing harm to the character and appearance of the Conservation Area contrary to policies D1, D2 and D3 of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017, DH1 and DH2 of the Hampstead Neighbourhood Plan.
