We propose to replace these windows with Conservation Area-compliant, slimline, double-glazed, UPVC "Ultimate Rose" sash windows. Full technical details of the latter are provided alongside this application. We note that the flat directly below ours appears to have UPVC casement windows to the front of the property abutting Perrins Court.
