T3- Yew - cut back to line of low wall beneath tree, removing approx 2M from lateral spread to create space and light, crown lift to 2.5M T4 & T5- x2 Sycamores - Trees both growing within fenceline. Cut back to fenceline, reduce to a standing height of 4M to reduce the risk of remaining crown failing as it is attached at base to a historic coppice.
