Dear Mr Marfleet

Further to my previous letter to you last year regarding GOSH Children's Cancer Centre Planning application.

As a local resident of Boswell Street for over 20 years I am writing once more to object even more strongly, to their latest (hardly) revised planning application.

I went to the drop in back on 10 November last year and spoke at length to the NHS / GOSH representative at the meeting, who simply had no answers to some of the many serious issues that I raised with others regarding this proposed development plan, and looked almost tearful at one point as I went through the potential short, and longterm negative impact the current proposal would have on the local community.

GOSH clearly has no intention of exploring adjustments to the build or even exploring alternative sites, when every pointer suggests either or both would be the right thing to do, for children's healthcare, the local community's health and well being, and the environment, with potential economic benefits to areas outside the capital, if relocation was the only alternative workable option.

I have spoken with numerous concerned and worried local residents, many of whom are still without any official resident's association, that feel intimidated by the size, complexity and sensitivity of the development to put forward their objections and concerns individually. On their behalf I humbly appeal to you and Camden not to give approval to what is still a poorly considered, dimensionally monstrous development proposal for the Great Ormond Street site.
