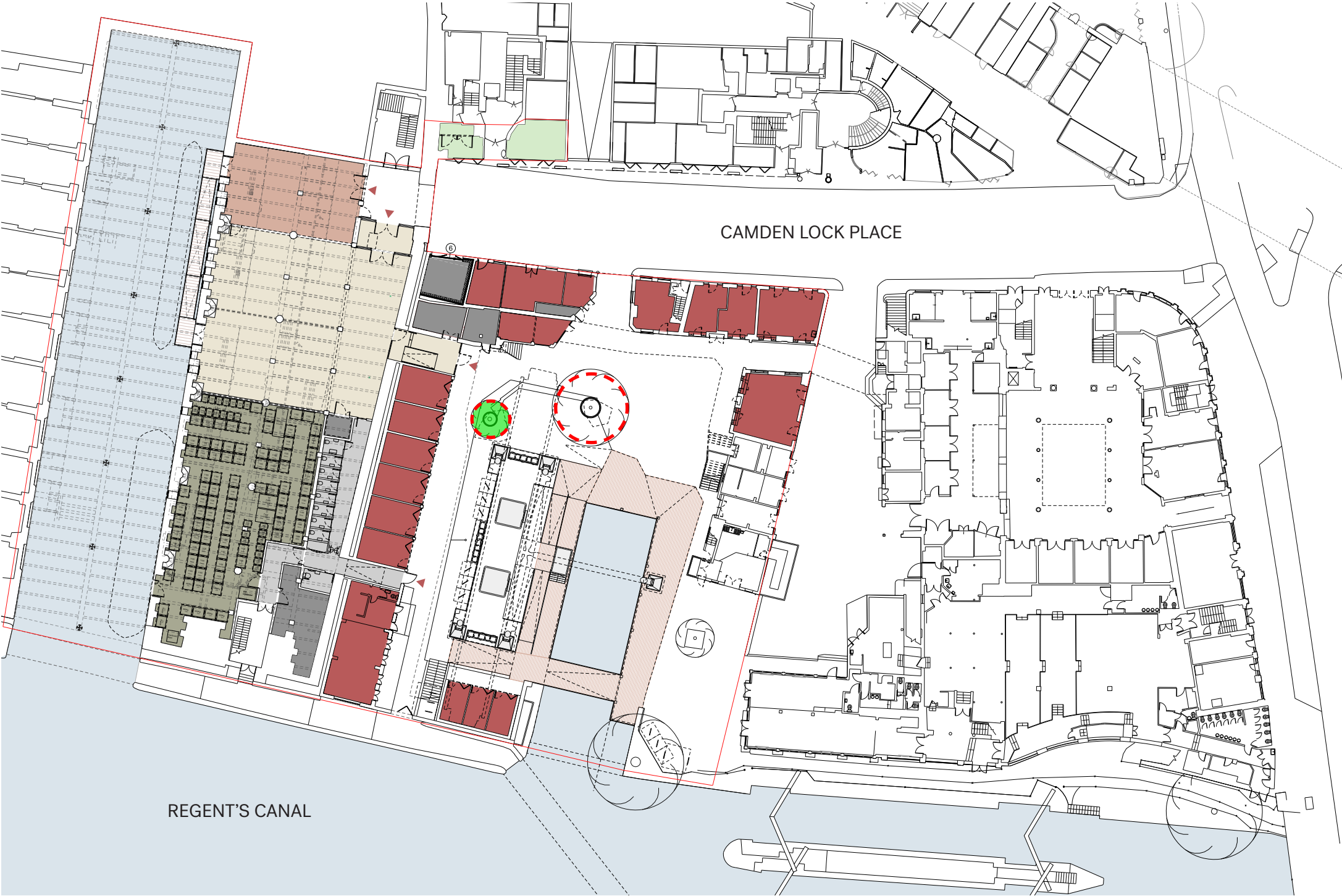

Soft Landscaping
A landscaping proposal has been developed by Greenways, which includes planting around the two trees to the north of the wheel.

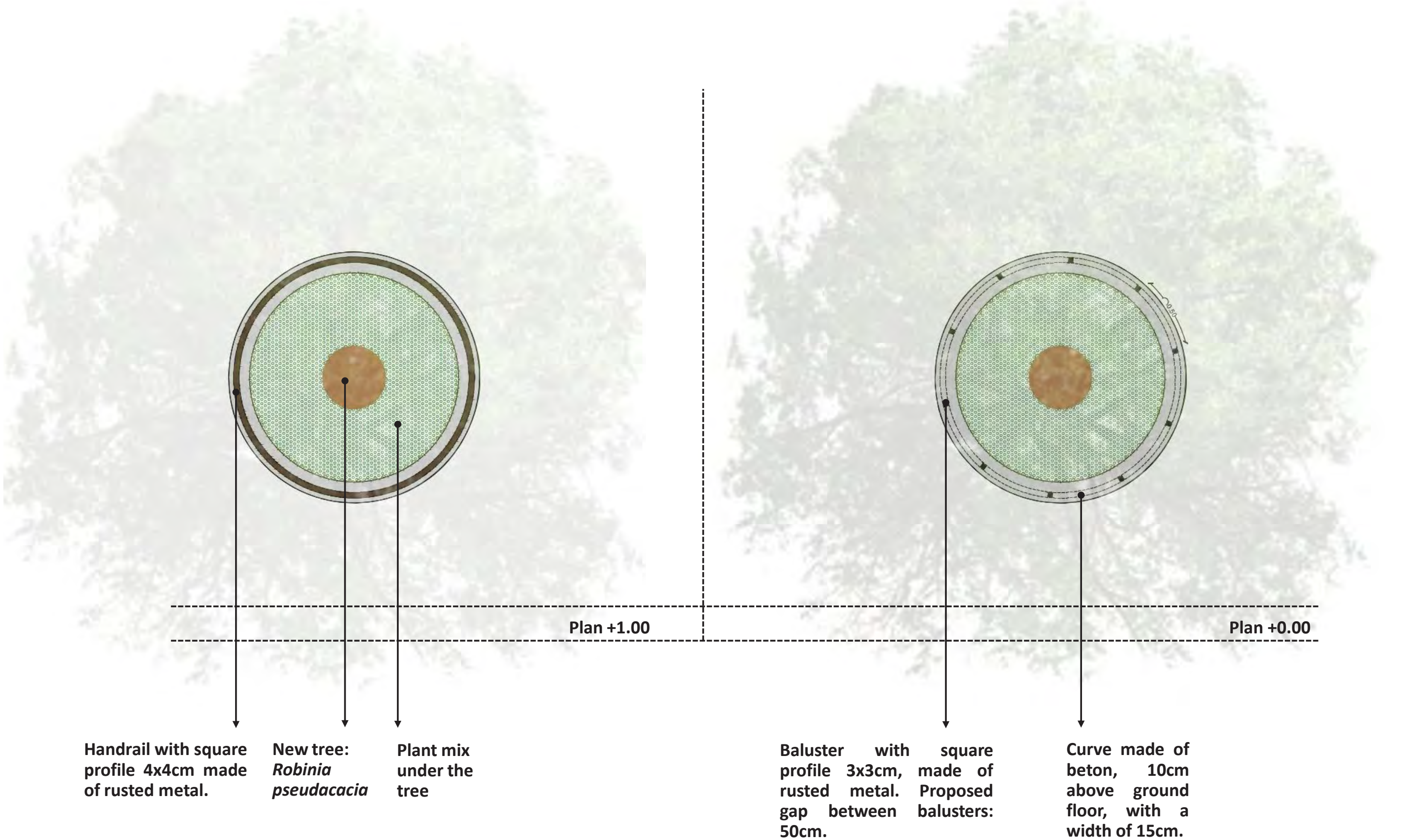

The proposed plant list includes plants species that thrive in the UK weather. The mix of salvias and gauras create a transparent filter, with movement and intense alternation of flowering colors during the seasons. As a stable plant volume we propose pitosporum, a small evergreen shrub.

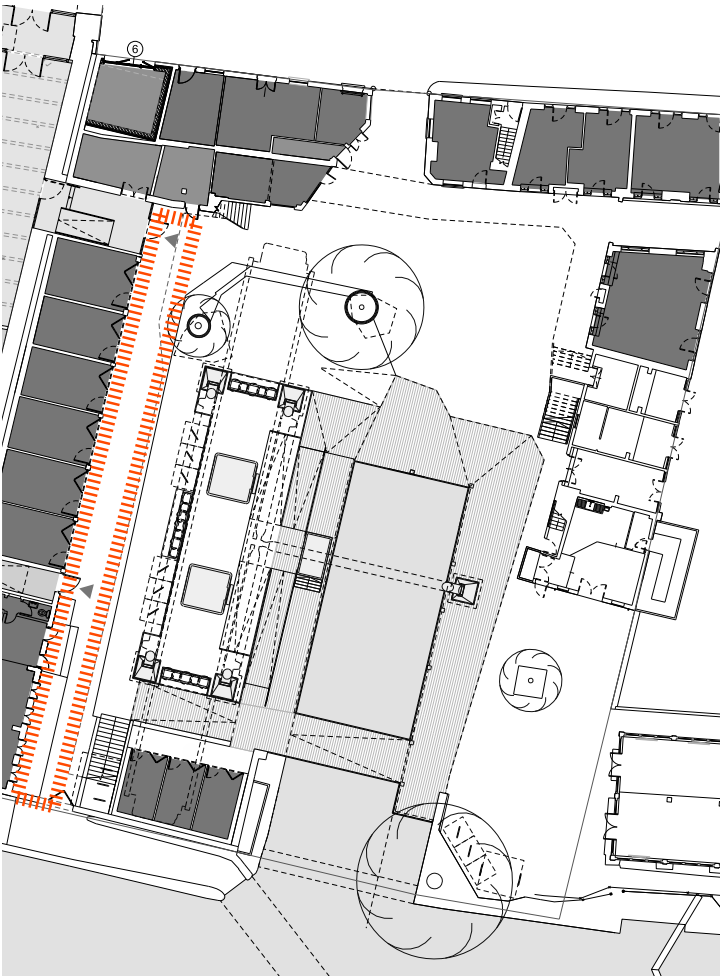

EXTERNAL LIGHTING PRINCIPLES

Studio Fractal has been commissioned to propose a lighting concept for updating the external lighting for West Yard. This includes refurbishing the lighting under the bridges and first floor deck around the yard, as well as lighting attached to the buildings.

The existing light fittings will be replaced, and the existing lighting totems on West Yard would be replaced with new lighting attached to the wheel.

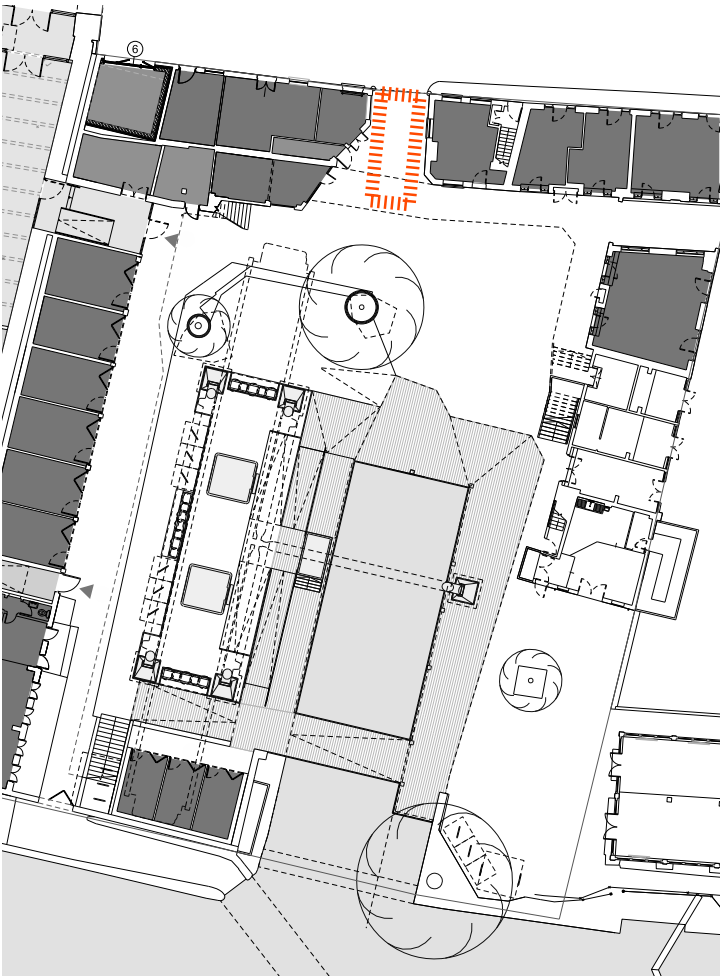
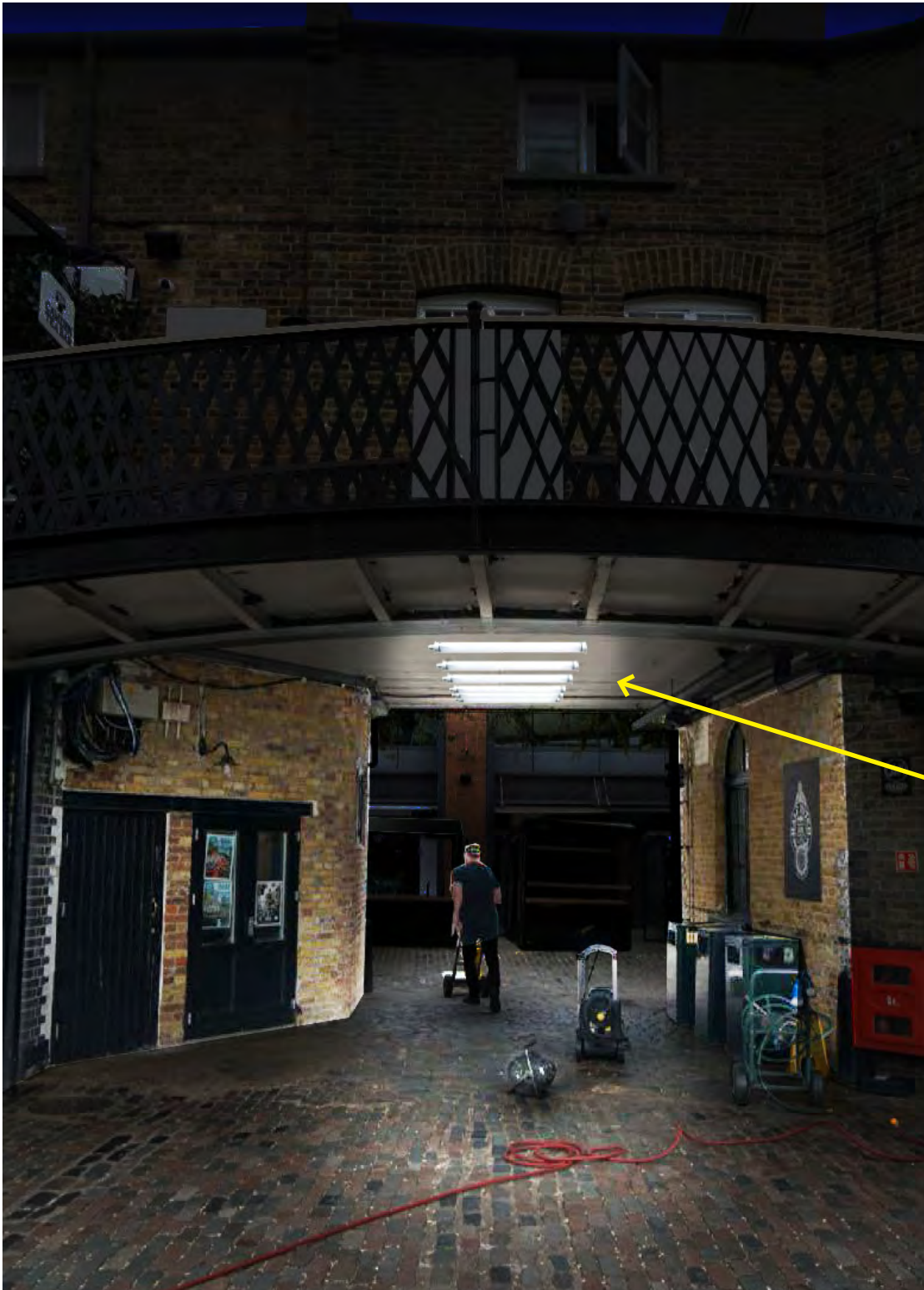
Whilst surveys have shown no current bat activity within the site, the lighting strategy ensures that bats flying along the canal will not be disrupted.

EARLS COURT GIANT WHEEL



BLACKPOOL GIGANTIC WHEEL

LONDON'S FIRST GIANT WHEEL AT EARL'S COURT, COMMEMORATING THE EMPIRE OF INDIA EXHIBITION, WAS MODELLED ON GEORGE OBSERVATION' ORIGINAL WHICH FEATURED AT THE 1893 WORLD COLUMBIAN EXPOSITION IN CHICAGO.

FINISHED IN 1895, THE EARLS COURT WHEEL CARRIED 2.5 MILLION PASSENGERS OVER THE COURSE OF ITS TEMPORARY 11 YEAR LIFESPAN. THE ONCE WORLD-FAMOUS LANDMARK IS NOW ALL BUT FORGOTTEN.

THE BLACKPOOL AND EARLS COURT WHEELS PRECEDED OTHER EUROPEAN GIANT WHEELS BUILT IN PARIS AND VIENNA OVER THE NEXT DECADES. ALL WERE REALISED BY THE SAME BRITISH ENGINEER - WALTER BASSETT.
