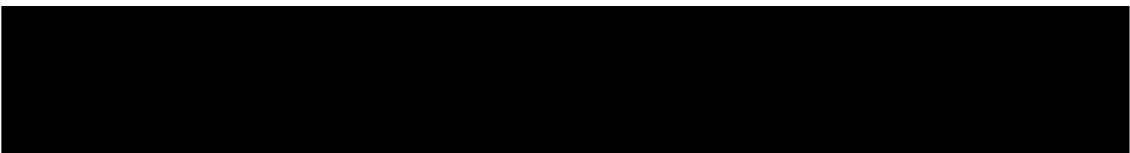


**Subject:** 4 Lutton terrace NW3 1HB - objection - officer 5458



*to Camden Council:*

*With regards to the new submission on 4 Lutton terrace, number 4. I would like to object again and clarify our position because:*

*Social fairness and justice is a concern with this particular development.*

*Developers and property owners rarely consider they are allowed to add new floors and windows that directly overlook or face a third party so closely, even less so within a conservation area, while adjoining listed buildings*

*The fact that it is social housing tenants will be the most impacted and suffer the greatest loss of quality of life as a result of this development should not improve the developer's chances to increase its project.*

*If the extension is built the front dormers will create a substantial intrusion into the Lutton terrace facing properties . it will also take away their natural light, I believe there is a solid case of discrimination and that legal aid from social housing rights will need to be sought.*
