I am writing on behalf of The Belsize Society to object to the felling of the above tree. The tree is in the Parkhill & Upper Park Conservation Area and the CA Management Strategy states: "The Council would generally resist the removal of trees within the conservation area unless they were dead/dying/dangerous, causing damage to buildings or not considered to be of visual or wildlife importance." The photo provided shows a mature pear tree that looks in need of pruning but, apart from that, it appears from the photo that the tree is healthy and vigorous. Felling should be the last resort so it is recommended that the tree should be pruned instead.
