BREACH OF CONDITION NOTICE

1. THIS NOTICE is served by the Council under section 187A of the above Act, because they consider that a condition imposed on a grant of planning permission, relating to the land described in paragraph 2 below, has not been complied with. The Council consider that you should be required to comply with the conditions specified in this Notice. The Annex at the end of this notice contains important additional information.

2. THE LAND TO WHICH THE NOTICE RELATES

Land at: **THE FORGE FOUNDRY 3-7 DELANCEY STREET, LONDON NW1 7NL** shown edged black on the attached plan.

3. THE RELEVANT PLANNING PERMISSION

The relevant Planning Permission to which this Notice relates is the planning permission Ref: 2011/3285/P variation of conditions 2 (opening hours of cafe/restaurant) and 6 (opening hours of music recital hall) of the planning permission dated 19/03/07 (2006/2680/P) for demolition of existing buildings and redevelopment of the site to provide a cafe/restaurant (Class A3) with an internal courtyard to link with a music/recital/practise hall (Sui Generis), and residential use on upper floors, namely to allow the cafe/restaurant and music recital hall to open from 08:00 till 00:00 Monday to Thursday, 08:00 till 01:00 Friday and Saturday and 08:00 till 22:30 Sunday and Bank Holidays.

4. THE BREACH OF CONDITION

The following condition has not been complied with:

Condition 1 of the planning permission namely: Live and recorded music shall not be played on the premises between 23.00 and 08.00 hours.

Condition 2 of the planning permission namely: The cafe/restaurant use hereby permitted shall not be carried out outside the following times: midnight to 0800 on Monday to Thursday, 0100 to 0800 Friday and Saturday and 2230 to 0800 on Sundays and Bank Holidays and no noise shall emanate from the premises within these times.

Condition 3 of the planning permission namely: The music recital hall use hereby permitted shall not be carried out during the following times: midnight to 0800 on Monday to Thursday, 0100 to 0800 Friday and Saturday and 2230 to 0800 on Sundays and Bank Holidays and no noise shall emanate from the premises within these times

The conditions has been breached in that:

1. Live and recorded music are being played outside of the hours stipulated on the relevant permission. The café/restaurant and music recital hall uses are being operated outside of the stipulated hours of operation stipulated on the relevant planning permission.

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

As the person responsible for the breach(es) of condition specified in Paragraph 4 of this Notice, you are required to comply with the stated conditions by taking the following steps:-

1. Ensure that live and recorded music is not played on the premises between 23.00 and 08.00 hours in accordance with condition (1) attached to planning permission granted on 24/08/2011 under reference 2011/3285/P;
2. Ensure that the cafe/restaurant use hereby permitted shall not be carried out outside the following times: midnight to 0800 on Monday to Thursday, 0100 to 0800 Friday and Saturday and 2230 to 0800 on Sundays and Bank Holidays and no noise shall emanate from the premises within these times in accordance with condition 2 attached to the planning permission granted on 24/08/2011 under reference 2011/3285/P; and
3. Ensure that the music recital hall use hereby permitted shall not be carried out outside the following times: midnight to 0800 on Monday to Thursday, 0100 to 0800 Friday and Saturday an/d 2230 to 0800 on Sundays and Bank Holidays and no noise shall emanate from the premises within these times in accordance with condition 3 attached to the planning permission granted on 24/08/2011 under reference 2011/3285/P.

Period for compliance:-

Twenty-eight (28) days from the receipt of this notice.

6. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT.

This notice takes effect immediately it is served on you or you receive it by postal delivery.

THERE IS NO RIGHT OF APPEAL TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT AGAINST THIS NOTICE.

It is an offence to contravene the requirements stated in paragraph 5 of this notice after the end of the compliance period. You will then be at risk of immediate prosecution in the Magistrates' Court, for which the maximum penalty is £2,500 for a first offence and for any subsequent offence. Explanatory Note

Section 187A of the Town & Country Planning Act 1990 Breach of Condition Notices states:

"Section 187A. Enforcement of Conditions.

(1) This section applies where planning permission for carrying out any development of land has been granted subject to conditions.

(2) The local planning authority may, if any of the conditions is not complied with, serve a notice (in this Act referred to as a 'breach of condition notice' on -

(a) any person who is carrying out or has carried out the development ; or

(b) any person having control of the land,

requiring him to secure compliance with such of the conditions as are specified in the notice.

(3) References in this section to the person responsible are to the person on whom the breach of condition notice has been served.

(4) The conditions which may be specified in a notice served by virtue of subsection (2) () are any of the conditions regulating the use of the land.

(5) A breach of condition notice shall specify the steps which the authority consider ought to be taken, or the activities which the authority consider ought to cease, to secure compliance with the conditions specified in the notice.

(6) The authority may be notice served on the person responsible withdraw the breach of condition notice, but its withdrawal shall not affect the power to serve on him a further breach of condition notice in respect of the conditions specified in the earlier notice or any other conditions.

(7) The period allowed for compliance with the notice is -

(a) such period of not less than twenty-eight days beginning with the date of service of the notice as may be specified in the notice ; or

(b) the period as extended by a further notice served by the local planning authority on the person responsible.

(8) If, at any time after the end of the period allowed for compliance with the notice

(a) any of the conditions specified in the notice is not complied with; and

(b) the steps specified in the notice have not been taken or, as the case may be, the activities specified in the notice have not ceased,

the person responsible is in breach of the notice.

(9) If the person responsible is in breach of the notice he shall be guilty of an offence.

(10) An offence under subsection (9) may be charged by reference to any day or longer period of time and a person may be convicted of a second or subsequent offence under that subsection by reference to any period of time following the preceding conviction for such an offence.

(11) It shall be a defence for a person charged with an offence under subsection (9) to prove -

(a) that he took all reasonable measures to secure compliance with the conditions specified in the notice ; or

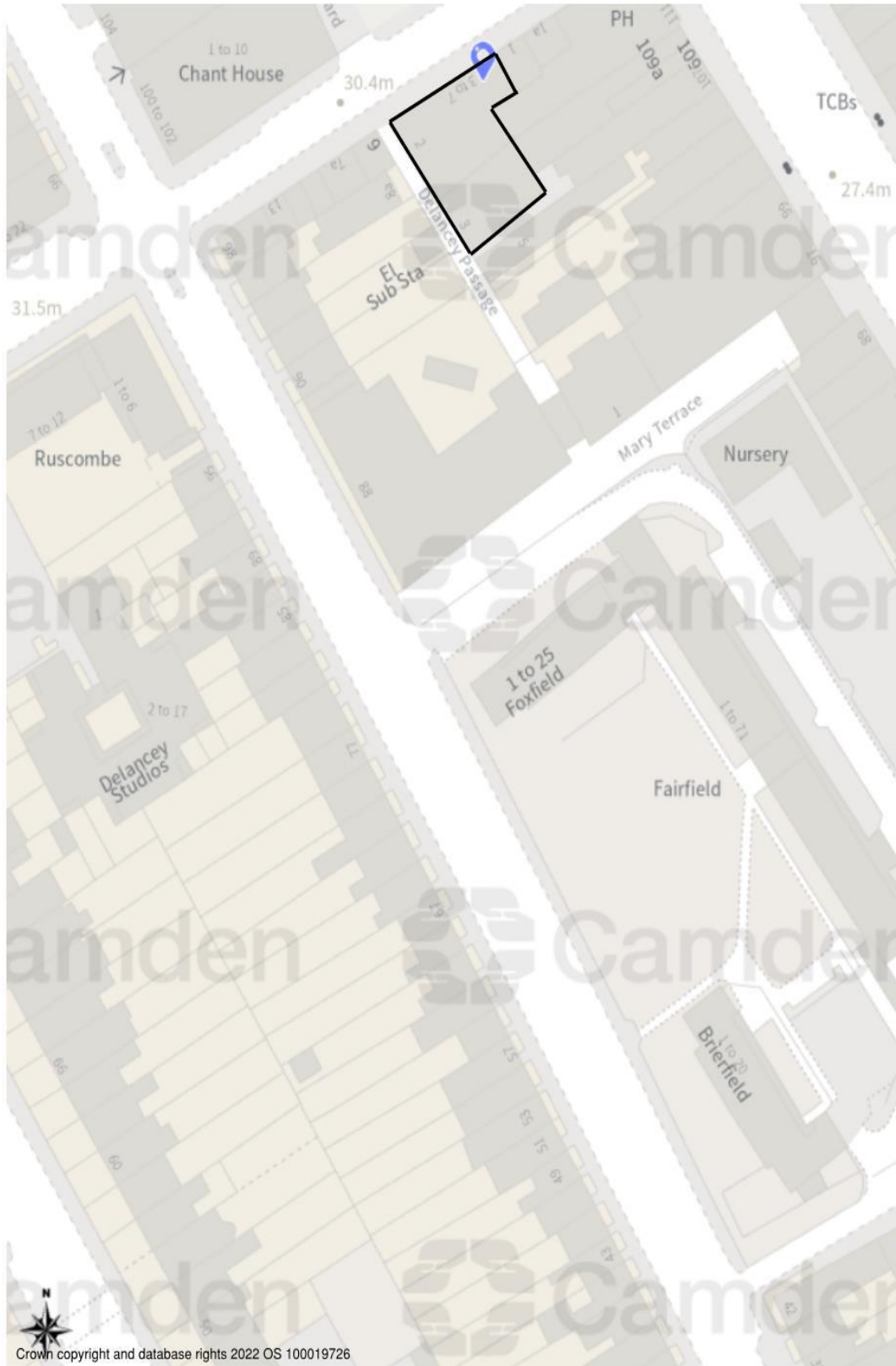
(b) where the notice was served on him by virtue of subsection (2) (), that he no longer had control of the land.

(12) A person who is guilty of an offence under subsection (9) shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.

(13) In this section -

(a) 'conditions' includes limitations; and

(b) references to carrying out any development include causing or permitting another to do so).
