Whilst sympathetic to those allergic to tree pollen, a balanced view needs to be taken. The main pollen season lasts a couple of months compared with the year-round benefits to the neighbourhood provided by trees. Also tree pollen drifts over a wide area and there are other birch trees in the area so the removal of the trees at 26 Belsize Grove may not eliminate the family's allergy problems. We therefore object to the felling of the two healthy trees.
