I would like to register my strong disapproval of the latest proposal for the Mansfield Bowling Club. It is far too large a scheme for the site. I have lived on Croftdown Road for 34 years and both the joy and annoyance of its location are the four local schools and Nursery School on York Rise that provide very busy pavements and traffic. The proposal would push the traffic flow and pressure on parking to unacceptable levels and indeed, in my opinion, endanger those who use what is already a busy set of pavements and crossings as well as the increase in traffic fumes for the children and locals.
