Technical Statement – Section 73, Energy Sustainability and Noise

1. Introduction

Hilson Moran are Consulting Engineers appointed by GMS for the redevelopment of Kingsway House for the design of building services engineering services as well as advice on energy sustainability and noise.

The works comprise the demolition of 6th and 7th floors and lift overrun and replacement with double mansard roof and set back 8th floor, with roof terrace above and internal reconfiguration to provide additional office and retail floor space. The works will include the provision of new building engineering services.

This document has been prepared to support the section 73 application.
