In the last year the owners of this property have extended their house out to the perimeter wall along which these limes were planted. It seemed obvious to anyone looking at the plans that the tree nearest the extension might be too near it, so it is surprising that this was not taken into consideration at planning stage. The tree in this row of trees furthest away from the house has become badly damaged during the process of construction by the delivery and removal of skips. Little care was taken to protect it. If the tree nearest the house is removed (as per the application), and if the tree furthest from the house dies because it is badly damaged, or cannot recover its form, then the row of four trees will be reduced to two and look incongruous. I am not making a case for rejecting the application but wish to make Camden aware of the considerations that must be taken into account by the tree officer in making his/her decision.</p>
