We started this process in October 2020 and erroneously did not get planning permissions as we did not believe it was required. The changes to the property as as follows: changing a window into a door (that leads to the garden) in the kitchen of the property. This is for more practical and safer access to the garden of the property. The door that has been installed (by Safestyle) meets all of the safety and aesthetic requirements imposed by the council. I also note that: 1) the council required us to carry out an asbestos survey (which was duly completed without any issues); 2) we got building control approval, and have since paid for the building control certificate; and 3) we have since paid for the Deed of Variation incorporating Licence for Alterations.
