we would like you to revisit our concerns about the proposed viewing balconies on the Camden Highline.

The Highline is as you know projecting 2.5 million footfall and is described as a new tourist attraction. We raised our concerns about the viewing platforms directing people to views off the Highline that unfortunately include private residential properties. We raised the issue of photos being put on social media raising privacy and security concerns. Grateful for your views on this before we seek legal advice.
