## Identification of Tree(s) and Description of Works

This schedule of work is based on tree management recommendations in Tree Survey AS/MF/080/22 (M.Foster 05/22).

Trees are itemised in correspondence with Tree Report (site plan on page 17).

All pruning cuts will be made strictly within British Standards of Arboriculture (BS3998) to help maintain the long term health of the trees.

T2) London Plane: Crown reduce over-extended lateral spread to north / north west - where required only - by up to 2.5m branch lengths to maximum 15m height to draw in over-extended laterals and balance with remainder of crown; Crown lift to 6m height removing secondary growth only; Remove major deadwood.

T3) London Plane: Crown lift to 6m height removing secondary growth only; Remove major deadwood.

T4) London Plane: Remove major deadwood; Crown lift to 6m height removing secondary growth only; Remove major deadwood.

T5) London Plane: Crown lift to 5m height removing secondary growth only; Remove major deadwood.

T6) London Plane: Crown lift to 6m height removing secondary growth only; Remove major deadwood.

T7) London Plane: Crown reduce over-extended lateral spread to east / south-east - where required only - by up to 2.5m branch lengths to maximum 15m height to draw in over-extended laterals and balance with remainder of crown; Crown lift to 6m height removing secondary growth only; Remove major deadwood.

T10) Purple Plum: Remove reversion growth from upper crown to restore natural form; Prune to balance maximum 1m branch lengths.

T11) London Plane: Crown lift to 5m height removing secondary growth only; Remove major deadwood.

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.

Where trees are protected by a Tree Preservation Order, please number them as shown in the First Schedule to the Tree Preservation Order where this is available. You should use the same numbering on your sketch plan (see below for sketch plan requirements).

- The number used on the sketch plan; and

- indicate the main features of the site where the tree(s) stand and its surroundings; in particular, you should:
  - mark and name surrounding roads
  - sketch in buildings, including adjoining properties
  - add house numbers or names
- mark the position of the tree(s) to which you want to carry out work and identify them by the number shown in the Tree Preservation Order where possible; if you use a different number, please make sure that this can be matched with your description of the tree(s)
- if there are many trees on the site, make clear which tree(s) are included in this application by:
  - $\circ\,$  marking all trees on the plan, but only numbering those to which you want to carry out work
  - showing the approximate distance between the application tree(s) and buildings
  - adding other relevant features on the site (e.g. greenhouse, paths)
