Policy D1 seeks high quality design in all alterations and developments. The Council will require that development respects the local context and character and are of high quality that compliments the local character. Furthermore, policy D2 will preserve, and where appropriate, enhance Camden's diverse assets and their settings including conservation areas.

The Bartholomew Estate Conservation Area Statement provides guidelines for rear extensions and sets out that rear extensions should be as unobtrusive as possible and the effect on neighbouring properties and the Conservation Area will be the basis of its suitability.

The building itself is not in a conservation area, but the Bartholomew Estate Conservation
Area is immediately to the rear of the site. It sits opposite a Grade II listed building, and although the application site is not listed, or included on the local list, it is clear that it has notable and significant historical significance. This is largely drawn from the form, detailing, and fenestration of the building. As it is not a designated asset, the impact on it is a matter of planning balance as a non-designated heritage asset. The alterations to the rear first floor are acceptable and they have been designed to stan back.

with minimal impact on the building, street and wider Bartholomew Estate Conservation Area which is adjacent, to the rear of the site. The green/ living roof is welcomed, details should be provided of this (including details of build-up and substrate in a section drawing) otherwise these details will need to be reserved by condition.

Details and materials of the extension, including the doors and windows, should be included on the proposed drawings.

Existing and proposed section drawings should also be provided through the extension. Rooflights were included in the withdrawn application but have not been shown in the preapplication drawings. Should the applicant wish to progress with an application for rooflights, as advised in email exchanges dated from 17 May to 22 June, detailed drawings of the rooflights should be provided to assess their impact accurately.

We advise they should sit flush with the roof slope, as a 'conservation style' roof light. If the roof light is positioned set back well into the roof area from the parapet edge that runs along Caversham Road. The height, position, slope gradient, and existing parapet, would mean they would be unlikely to be visible from Kentish Town Road or Caversham Road, so will not harm the conservation area.

In summary, the alterations to at the rear of the building would be visible in public views, but subject to detailed design and the advice in this letter, the extension is unlikely to harm the character and appearance of the host building and surrounding conservation area. As such, the first-floor rear extension would comply with policies D1 and D2 of the Camden Local Plan.
