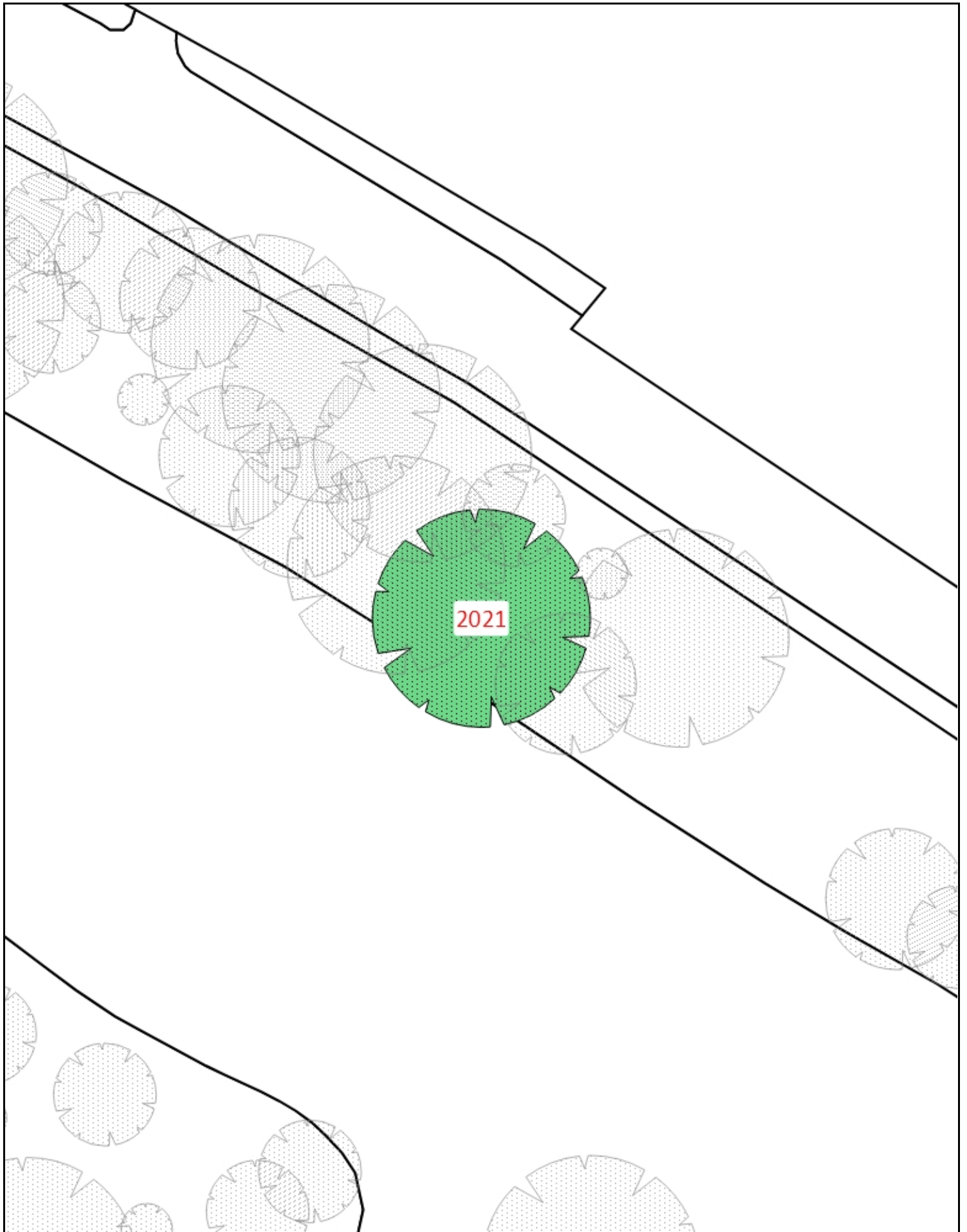


**Authority:** Camden
