I refer to the Location Plan, labelled as relating to 5, Tanza Road, presumably in an attempt to conceal by this deception an unlawful attempt to appropriate, in the proposed development, property belonging to Oakford Court, Nassington Road. As you will know from earlier objections from Oakford Court residents, Mr. Norden has already claimed rights over the boundary shared between Oakford Court and 28 Parliament Hill. ( See Mr. Norden¿s earlier submission). This claim to ownership of our brick boundary wall and pillars, all residents of Oakford Court have resisted.</p> <p>This time Mr. Norden has submitted a mislabelled location plan. On this plan he marks the boundary of Oakford Court in red, inexplicably and erroneously including a brick pillar which belongs, clearly, to Oakford Court. This fact, the fact that the pillar claimed stands on the Oakford Court side of the boundary line, is clearly shown in Oakford Court title deeds already submitted to yourself.</p> <p>I am hoping that Camden will take this matter seriously, as clearly Mr. Norden has no respect for the right of other people to peacefully enjoy their own property.</p>
