Further to my current application 2023/0663/T, I had a visit yesterday from a tree surgeon who was estimating cost of the works to the six Leylandii in the garden here so that I might be ready to proceed with the works should approval be forthcoming in due course.

He advised me that urgent additional work should also be carried out to a 30-metre-high Silver Birch, which lost a major limb in heavy winds a couple of years ago and is now, in his words, 'unbalanced and leaning to one side' over the neighbouring garden. He advised that the tree should be reduced by one-third.

May I submit another, separate planning application for work to this effect? If permission is also granted for this work, I would then organise so that all the tree works are done together, I am attaching photos of the tree along with a map of the garden which is the one that was included with my previous Leylandii application.
